Meadowslea stud cows winter on unimproved native tussock blocks without supplements being fed. This challenging environment tests the ability of the pregnant cow to maintain condition through periods of winter feed shortages. It is the energy stored in her rib fat levels that enable her to survive, thrive, and ultimately get back in calf and rebreed each year.

Days to calving is a crucial fertility trait that measures the number of days from when the bull is let into the mob until the cow calves. This identifies cow families that calve early every year. Those earlier calves will always be heavier at weaning, and selecting for short Days to Calving will reduce later born calves and allow higher conception rates in a shorter mating period.

"At Meadowslea we have always had some of the highest rib fat levels in the Angus breed. The importance of these fat levels is now recognised with our cattle now having some of the shortest days to calving EBVs in Australasia."

GOOD FAT COVER AND EASY-DOING ABILITY



Meadowslea stud 18mth in-calf heifers showing good fat coverings and ready to winter on the hill.



Meadowslea cows and calves come down off the hill for weaning.

A cow's condition and her ability to lay down fat in times of surplus, and to draw on that fat as an energy source in times of feed deficit is vitally important. This rib and rump fat is the cheapest and most efficient energy store on the farm, and will determine the ability of the herd to get back in-calf and rebreed early after a hard winter or difficult spring.

All Meadowslea yearling heifers are mated and any drLHs culled. After calving these heifers are run in mating mobs together with mixed age cows and expected to get back in calf early, rear a good calf off the tussock, and stay in good order. This is a tough ask for a first-calver, but this year that age-group scanned with a terrific 98% back in calf !

A cow going into winter with good fat coverings carries an energy store on her back equivalent to approximately 2 bales of baleage.

The Meadowslea herd has natural rib and rump fat levels amongst the highest in the breed in Australasia – acknowledged as a key trait for fertility in the harsh environment.

Sale Format

The sale will be conducted as a Helmsman-style auction, meaning that all lots are for sale simultaneously. This is to allow for the participation of those in attendance, as well as those online. The sale will be hosted on our own **yourbid** platform and accessed through our website www.meadowslea.co.nz. Prior to the sale, all lots will be filmed and available for viewing up until sale day on the Meadowslea website.

Bulls are available for viewing in the paddock anytime – just call 0272299760 to arrange a time.

Registration for those in attendance will be at the on-farm office, where a copy of the conditions of sale will be posted.

Registration for those online will be through the Meadowslea website, where the conditions of sale will also be available.

Buyers will receive a buyer number as they register which will accompany each bid. Buyers registering online will receive a buyer number in their email which will automatically accompany each bid they place, whether they do so at home on their computer, or through their smart phone while in attendance. Those in attendance may also bid by writing on the supplied bidding cards and handing them in to the auctioneers. All live bids and all lots will be visible at all times, both online and on a big screen on-farm.

Online registration is available NOW and we encourage everyone to visit our website www.meadowslea.co.nz, to register, and then place practice bids on the demonstration lots on the auction page.

The on-line open day videos will be released on our website www.meadowslea.co.nz in the days leading up to the sale. These videos will include footage of every bull with in-depth comments and will be available for viewing in the lead-up to, and during, the sale

Online bidding will be open at 7pm on June 10th until the conclusion of the sale.

On Sale Day, June 17th, the on-farm registration and bidding will open at 3pm.

Livestreaming with interactive viewing will commence at 12.30 pm with a walk through of all the pens with commentary from the vendors and genetic specialists. Requests to review particular cattle can be made through the comments section of the web-site chat room or by telephone or text to the vendors or stock agents in attendance. This will continue throughout until the conclusion of the sale.

A live screen on the website will show all lots alongside their current prices and the buyer number of the bidder who holds that lot. On-farm attendees will be able to view on a big screen on site. Bids will be displayed on a computer or smart phone screen in the following colours

Example:

\$2500 displayed in red denotes the vendor's reserve and indicates there has been no bid

\$3000 displayed in blue means an active bid has been received

\$3500 orange highlight indicates a new bid has been received within the last 2 minutes on this lot

\$3500 the holder of the leading bid will have the lot number highlighted in green on their computer or their smart phone. The bidding increment will be \$500

The sale will run until 5pm on June 17th. After this time the sale will conclude once there has been a period of at least 2 minutes without a bid being received on any lot. If another bid is placed on any lot during the 2-minute period, then time is extended and bids can be received on all lots for a further 2 minutes. This process will be repeated until a clear 2 minutes passes without any bids on any lot at which time the sale will conclude.

Final Time will be called clearly by the commentary team who will use their discretion to ensure all bidders are satisfied.

All updates will be posted on our website, as will an up-to-date version of this document.

FOREWORD

Meadowslea Angus Stud was established in 1985 with the purchase of 6 capital stock heifers from the well-known Turihaua Stud north of Gisborne. We have steadily expanded ever since to meet strong demand for bulls from the hill-country market we target – our belief is that an animal must first and foremost be suitable for the environment in which it is run.

With the lease and purchase of neighbouring properties over the last 10 years we have taken the opportunity to increase the stud cow numbers further, and this year mated a total of 730 stud females. The demand for our bulls has steadily increased with 170 bulls sold at auction in 2025. With 230 bull calves born in 2024 the bar has been very high to make the 2026 sale team and we this is definitely reflected in the quality of this catalogue.

Selection criteria are for easy fleshing, moderate framed cattle, with plenty of meat and adequate fat cover, that will shift and perform in the South Island hill-country. Sires used are all NZ bred with real emphasis placed on the maternal and fertility traits as well as structural soundness. Over the last 15 years our cows have grazed on Steve and Sue Kerr's neighbouring Berkley Downs property, on native tussock blocks to an altitude of over 2500 feet. Wintering without supplements through adverse conditions has further tested their hardiness and constitution, and clearly shown us the type that suits our country and even more importantly our clients' properties.

As you read this catalogue it will become clear that the animals that perform the best in our environment are of a similar type – strong rib fat levels drive our programme forward for two reasons. Rib fat is strongly linked to fertility, early puberty and the ability to calve early and re-breed early over a lifetime. Secondly, it is the energy store the females use to get through the feed shortages and extended stress periods all too common in this harsh environment. It is significant that the average rib fat EBV of all the bulls on offer is +2.3, ranking them in the top 25% for the breed in Australasia.

Very dry conditions in inland Canterbury through early 2024 served as a stark reminder of the type of cattle needed to perform in tough environments. It was the thick deep bodied easy doing cows and heifers with plenty of fat that held their condition and continued to milk and wean good calves – the old adage that it is the fat on the cows back that determines the weight of her calf has never been truer!

At Meadowslea all yearling heifers are mated. In 2024 we had 227 stud heifers born and we mated almost all as yearlings in 7 different mobs selected on pedigree, performance, and type. The result was a 97% conception rate and is a huge endorsement of the emphasis we place on the key fertility and maternal traits that are the main drivers of profitability in any beef herd. The performance of our young genetics is again leading the progress within the herd, with over 50% of the bulls in this catalogue either sired by yearling bulls or out of 2-year heifers.

The key fertility trait of Days to Calving measures how soon cows calve after the bull is introduced, with shorter values reflecting a higher likelihood of being in-calf in the first cycle. The bulls in this catalogue average -4.9 days, which is in the top 30% of the breed. The other important maternal traits of calving ease, scrotal size, and milk are also generally at very high levels throughout the catalogue. High-growth females do not work well in our hill-country environment and over time they have failed to perform and so have dropped out of the herd. Consequently, bulls with excessive high growth do not feature in this catalogue.

Our proven senior sires, Turihaua Crump, Meadowslea F540, and Meat Machine G914, were all breed trait leaders for the fertility traits of calving ease, or short days to calving, and now all rank in the top 1% of the new Angus NZ Body Condition Score (BCS). The mixes of these bloodlines within the bulls in this catalogue offer very exciting options for improving profitability in our clients' herds. The \$81000 Kincardine Rainstorme is again the feature sire with 12 sons on offer, 10 of which were used in the stud as yearlings, and offer exciting performance.

Meadowslea clients find our moderate-framed, early-maturing, easy-doing cattle prime up quickly, and are easily finished to grade and marbled at a young age enabling them to meet the very attractive market premiums now available for prime Angus beef.

With a total of 21 pieces of data now presented in catalogues, this can be a bewildering array of numbers for most commercial farmers and indeed stud breeders. We encourage clients to look primarily at the Self-Replacing Index in the first instance.



FOREWORD CONTINUED

We have found this to be a very useful tool for distilling this array of figures into a useful framework that reflects genuine profitability in NZ hill country conditions, and it is the primary metric we use for selecting and comparing cattle ourselves.

Meadowslea retain semen rights for in-herd use only on all bulls catalogued, unless by arrangement.

All bulls on offer will undergo Beef Class Structural Assessment inspection and the scores for the individual lots will be published online and be available in hard copy on sale day.

All Meadowslea bulls come with a 3-year guarantee, and we stand behind them 100%.

Stud Transfers - Any bulls sold for stud transfer will be at a minimum price of \$15,000.

Comments: Purchased in May 2022 for \$81,000, Rainstorme is one of the most exciting sires we have used at Meadowslea. He ticks all the boxes for efficient beef production on hill country and has generated widespread interest from stud and commercial breeders in both NZ and Australia, with semen and embryo sales of over \$100,000 recorded to date. Rainstorme has the unusual combination of data that is backed up by viewing the bull himself. His massive EMA is visible in his exceptional loin, and his easy doing ability with his strong fats is very evident. His wonderful smooth shoulder confirms his calving ease trait leader status and his massive scrotal is also industry leading. He now has over 330 recorded progeny across 30 herds in NZ and Australia and his exceptional data set has not altered. The first of his 2yr sons were a real feature of our 2025 bull sale selling to \$36000. We used 10 sons as yearlings to mate both stud heifers and cows in the 2025 mating, and they are set to make a very strong impact on the 2026 June bull sale line-up. Rainstorme has a total of 12 sons on offer and they all display the same easy calving clean shoulders with superb temperament and wonderful fleshing with a data set to match.

MEADOWSLEA MARK 100 YEARS OF STUD BREEDING

2025 marks a significant milestone for the Giddings family of Fairlie as they celebrate a century of breeding Romney sheep on the same Meadowslea property.

It was 1925 when Gilbert Giddings then still a teenager took the train to Gore and purchased 40 stud Romney ewes. He wasn't old enough to have them registered in his own name and so the first Meadowslea Romneys were registered in his mother's name – Mrs Sarah Giddings.

The stud today is run by Gilbert's son David and his son George. George has a 2-year-old son named Gilbert all living on the Meadowslea property.

The Meadowslea Stud sheep flock currently consists of around 3000 recorded ewes run over 4 properties. As well as the base Meadowslea Romney flock, the operation now includes worm resistant Kiki South Romneys, Romdales, Texel x Romney, Perendale x Texel x Romney, Kelso x K Romney, as well as a black face Terminator breed. All the breeds are run entirely unshepherded with high survival, and low input easy care, the cornerstone of the breeding programme.

MEADOWSLEA ANGUS HISTORY

In 1986 David Giddings met Hamish Williams from Turihaua Angus at a Romney stud dispersal sale in Otago. Hamish was establishing a Romney stud at the time, and the conversation that followed led to a reciprocal agreement to exchange capital stock young females over a 3 year period. In 1987 Hamish travelled to Meadowslea and picked 20 in lamb stud Romney 2th ewes, and David visited Turihaua and selected 6 in calf capital stock 2yr heifers. These foundation females were wonderful traditional NZ bloodlines, at a time when the bigger framed USA genetics were becoming increasingly popular with Angus breeders in NZ.

David says at the time he had no idea these were some of the only capital stock females to ever be sold from Turihaua and the Giddings family are eternally grateful to the Williams family for the incredible opportunity. From those original 18 heifers, Meadowslea Angus has grown to be mating 720 stud females annually, as well as holding NZ's biggest annual female production sale. This has all been possible due to the incredible fertility and structural soundness of the Turihaua herd, which was an industry leader in mating yearling heifers back in 1987.

David says while there have been massive changes in breeding and performance over all those years, some things haven't changed at all, with the fundamentals of structural soundness, strong constitution, and fertility, as relevant today as they were back in 1925.

EBVS EXPLAINED

ANGUS NZ EBV'S AND SELECTION INDEXES

EBVs and Selection Indexes remove the effects of non-genetic factors (e.g. feeding regimes, animal age) to provide the best measure of an animal's genetic merit.

To ensure the accuracy of EBV and Index data, Angus NZ combine with Angus Australia to create a reference population known as the TransTasman Angus Cattle Evaluation (TACE).

By using TACE – along with visual and structural appraisal – will assist in creating a balanced phenotypical and genotypical breeding outcome.

SELECTING YOUR NEXT ANGUS NZ SIRE

1. Consider your individual EBVs of importance
2. Consider other traits of importance (e.g. visual assessment)
3. Identify the Angus NZ selection index of most relevance to your breeding programme
4. Rank animals using the chosen Selection Index.

The majority of these steps can be undertaken online at www.angusnz.com, allowing you to generate a shortlist of bulls ahead of sale day. Alternatively Beef & Lamb Genetics have developed a new tool to make it easier to find the best bulls for your farming operation. Using a series of buttons and sliders, you refine your breeding objectives, then click a button and nProve generates a list of bulls that best fit. It's free to use, there's no need to register and there's also helpful tips to get started.

GROWTH

200, 400 & 600 Day Weight EBVs (kg) – Larger (or more positive) Weight EBVs are expected to produce progeny that grow faster to 200, 400 & 600 days of age, respectively. The Weight EBV of particular importance will depend on the target market e.g. vealer (200 D), yearling (400 D) or heavy steer (600 D).

Mature Cow Weight (kg) – Larger (or more positive) MCW EBVs are expected to produce daughters with higher mature cow weights and increased feed requirements. More moderate MCW EBVs are generally more favourable in self replacing or maternal production systems.

Milk (kg) – Higher (or more positive) Milk EBVs are expected to produce daughters with more maternal ability leading to higher 200 day weights in their progeny. Selection for moderate Milk EBVs may be preferable in harsher environments as cows with higher Milk EBVs can have impaired fertility and decreased survival under such conditions.

FERTILITY & BIRTH

Calving Ease Direct (%) – Higher (or more positive) CEDir EBVs indicate 2 year old heifers will have less difficulty calving this sire's progeny.

Calving Ease Daughters (%) – Higher (or more positive) CEDtr EBVs indicate easier calving of this sire's daughters at 2 years.

Gestation Length (days) – Lower (or more negative) GL EBVs are expected to produce progeny with shorter gestation lengths. Such progeny are also expected to be easier calving.

Birth Weight (kg) – Lower, less positive BWt EBVs are expected to produce progeny that are lighter at birth, with an associated lower risk of calving difficulty. This EBV is particularly important when selecting sires where there is an increased risk of calving difficulty (e.g. heifers, cross-breeding).

Days to Calving (days) – Lower (or more negative) DTC EBVs are expected to produce daughters that are more fertile and have a shorter interval date to calving.

Scrotal Size (cm) – Larger (or more positive) SS EBVs indicate better semen quality and quantity. Daughters are expected to be more fertile and reach puberty at an earlier age.

CARCASE

Carcase Weight (kg) – Bulls with larger (or more positive) CWt EBVs are expected to produce progeny with heavier carcase weights.

Eye Muscle Area (sq. cm) – Bulls with a higher (or more positive) EMA EBV are expected to produce progeny with better muscling.

Rib and Rump Fat EBVs (mm) – Bulls with higher (or more positive) Rib & Rump Fat EBVs are expected to produce fatter progeny, relative to carcase weight. The desire for more or less fat will depend on the finishing ability of your animals.

Retail Beef Yield (%) – Bulls with higher (or more positive) RBY EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat (%) – Higher (or more positive) IMF EBVs are expected to produce progeny with more marbling and better grading scores (e.g. MSA).

OTHER EBVS

Docility (%) – Higher (or more positive) DOC EBVs are expected to produce more progeny with acceptable temperament.

Angus NZ Selection Indexes

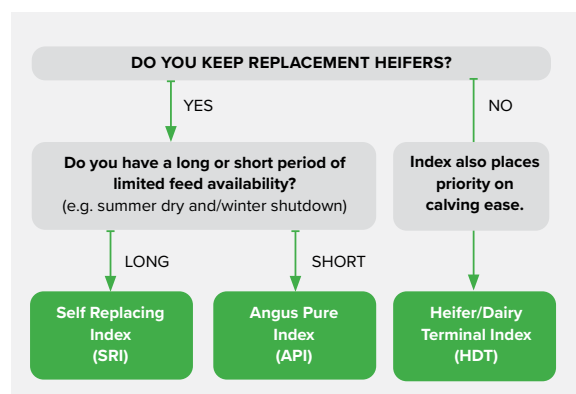
Angus NZ currently has three different selection indexes. These are:

1. Self Replacing Index
2. AngusPure Index; and
3. Heifer/Dairy Terminal Index

Each selection index is reported in units of net profitability/cow mated (\$), and relates to a commercial herd using Angus bulls. Each index is focused on efficient beef production, including maternal traits where appropriate.

NEW SALE SYSTEM CELEBRATES ITS 6TH BIRTHDAY

Yourbid, the online Helmsman auction system developed by Meadowslea Genetics of Fairlie, celebrated it's 6th birthday at the stud's recent in-calf female sale on April 29th.

The stud holds 7 on-farm sales a year across their sheep and Angus cattle breeding operations, including the annual in-calf sale in early May. In 2020, this date fell within NZ's Level 3 Covid lockdown, during which no crowds or gatherings were permitted, making an outcry auction impossible.

With feed supplies tight and meat processing capacity limited, deferring the sale really wasn't an option either, meaning the only way forward was to hold it online. After looking at the various options available, the Meadowslea team decided to design their own from the ground up.

After running helmsman sales for many years for ram sales and in-lamb ewe sales previously, David and son George Giddings could see how an online helmsman sale would work very well for stud stock. They were able to provide a webdesigning friend with a specific brief, and a week or so later Yourbid came into being. The sale was very strong, with spirited bidding from around New Zealand, despite no buyers being in attendance at all.

Since that first sale in 2020, Meadowslea have run 30 successful sales for their own stock, as well as a number of sales for other stud breeders in NZ and Scotland. The system has proven very popular with stud-stock buyers, giving them the extra time to consider their purchases carefully, and the option of buying in choice order rather than lot number order.

As well as the In-calf sale, Meadowslea annually run 2 bull sales, an online semen sale, and 3 ram sales on Yourbid. Yourbid has been used very successfully for studstock sales in Scotland, and the Giddings family have received enquiry from breeders keen to use it from around New Zealand as well as in Australia, France, the US and as far afield as Romania. 3 other ram breeding operations have used it in New Zealand this summer, with a number of bull sales confirmed for the upcoming season and many more interested in switching to it over the next few years.

Online helmsman-style auction

Yourbid works as a Helmsman-style auction - meaning all lots are offered for sale simultaneously.

Other online livestock sales platforms in New Zealand use the traditional sequential auction model, whereby each lot is sold one at a time, one after the other. Yourbid uses the "Helmsman" style of auction. This means that all the lots on the sale are open for bidding at the same time, which is helpful for both buyers and sellers, particularly when conducted online. Bidding is also kept open over a period of several days, rather than the minute or so per lot of a conventional auction.

A key difference of this platform compared to any other the developers have seen is the bidding screen which shows the current prices of all lots simultaneously. Reserve prices are shown in red for a start, this changes to blue once the first bid is received, and the buyer number of the current leading bidder is displayed. New bids are highlighted in orange for a minute. Buyers who are logged in on their own device see the lots they hold highlighted in green. This gives an instant overview of the auction so anyone can see on which lots the activity and interest is, making it easy to establish their relative market values.

All online models have some level of time delay between when events happen on-site and when they are seen by remote buyers. For a traditional sequential auction a delay of 15-20 seconds can be very significant, when each animal might only be in the ring for 90 seconds or so. By keeping the entire auction open for a longer period of time this problem is mitigated significantly. It also means sales will not be affected significantly by any temporary technological glitches.

Giving buyers time

Selecting seedstock is a major decision for sheep and beef farmers, and one which will have ramifications on their operations for years to come. People need time to gather and process information to make decisions. This is even more important when buying remotely, when information gathering is more difficult and takes time – meaning remote buyers are significantly disadvantaged at an online sequential auction. The Yourbid system gives buyers this extra time, and



by integrating the bidding on the website alongside the online catalogue, videos of each lot and a live commentary, this information is readily available to buyers. Rather than turning up on a given day and viewing all the animals in that tight time-frame, buyers can go through the catalogue, view the videos, make selections, and bid at their leisure from home over the period of several days the sale is open.

Bidding order of preference

Another advantage of a Helmsman-style auction is that it allows buyers to bid on stock in the order of their preference, rather than the catalogue order. For instance, as a buyer you might be interested in lot 8 and lot 12. At a traditional auction, lot 8 comes into the ring and isn't selling for too much, however lot 12 is your first preference so you decide to wait for that animal to come into the ring. Lot 12 comes in, sells for too much money, and you can't go back and bid on lot 8 because that animal is sold. Under the Helmsman system buyers can chop and change throughout the bidding. Meadowslea have analysed the bidding data for the sales they have run already, and it is obvious that a lot of buyers will bid on a certain lot to a particular level, then change to another lot, then perhaps go back to the first, or move onto a third animal they like. Some buyers bid on as many as 8 different animals to get the one they wanted – in a conventional auction they would have missed out completely or ended up with one that wasn't in their top-10 at all. By running the auction over a longer period, those who missed out on their first choice were able to go back through the videos and catalogue (or back through the pens for those who were actually onsite) and pick another animal they were satisfied with.

Integrating on-farm and online bidding

Integration of on-farm and on-line bids is crucial to the success of a platform like this. This system works by having large TVs on-farm displaying the bidding screen. Buyers on-site can bid through their smart phones, and those bids are displayed in real time. Some buyers will still prefer to attend on-farm and bid using pieces of paper as per a traditional Helmsman sale – they write their buyer number, their lot number, and the bid price on a piece of paper and hand it in – they are able to enter this directly into the online system so it shows up on-screen in real-time as well.

Engaging with potential buyers

By providing a live-chat on the platform, potential buyers are able to ask questions, request another closer view or more information about a particular lot, and even send through jokes and one-liners. Online videos and the livestreamed commentary are produced through Facebook Live. All this makes for a much more engaging and entertaining environment for the buyers, compared to what many feel are the sterile and austere atmospheres of some of the other established online platforms.

Yourbid invite enquiry from breeders, agents and commercial farmers interested in using the platform, and envisage it becoming an independent platform able to be used by all industry players.

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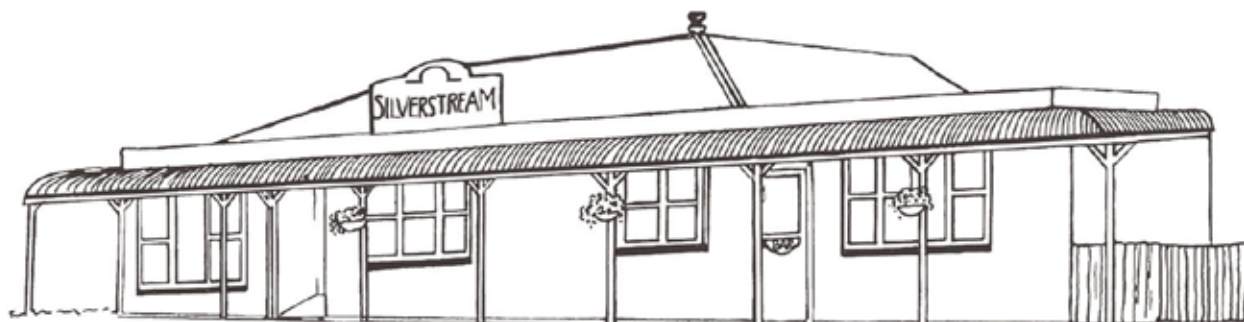

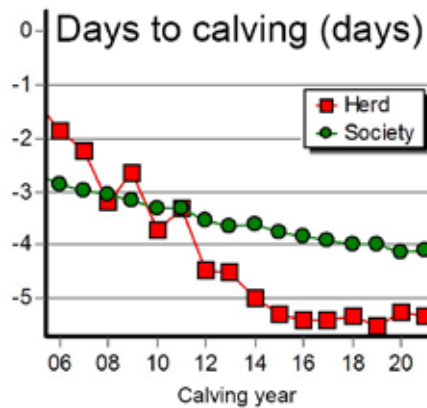

By putting pressure on cows to winter on native hill blocks it quickly became apparent that some animals could manage well in this environment and would easily get back in calf the next year, while those that struggled would be too light going to the bull, and either calve later each year, or come through dry.

Those that were dry or were not holding their condition well enough were removed from the stud herd, while the “easy-doing” types thrived and passed their genetics on to the next generation. It was clear that it was the cows with good fat covers going in to the winter that were consistently performing the best in our environment.

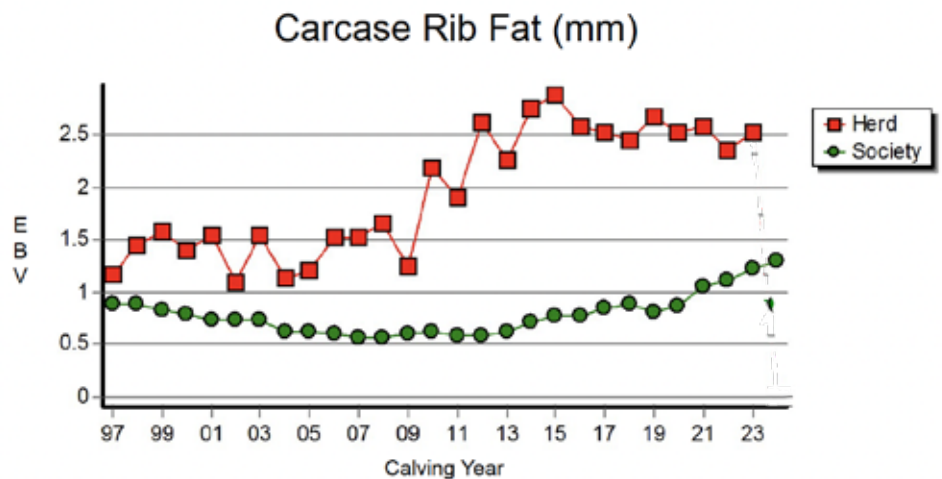
Ultrasound scanning is performed on all yearling bulls in early spring, and on the heifers in the autumn. For us, the most important data is the rib and rump fat cover measurement - we have found these strongly correlate with those easy doing characteristics, and we now put a lot of emphasis on this when selecting bulls to use and heifers to retain. This is reflected in Meadowslea having some of the highest fat EBVs on the Trans Tasman Angus Cattle Evaluation.

These great positive fat EBVs in the Meadowslea herd have come about simply by selecting animals that suit the hill country environment.



The all-important fertility trait of Short Days to Calving measures how quickly cows calve from the time the bull is introduced and is a major influence of beef herd profitability. The more negative the better.

Graph showing the short days to calving EBV average for the Meadowslea herd compared to the NZ average, with major progress made by selecting for early maturing, fertile cattle.

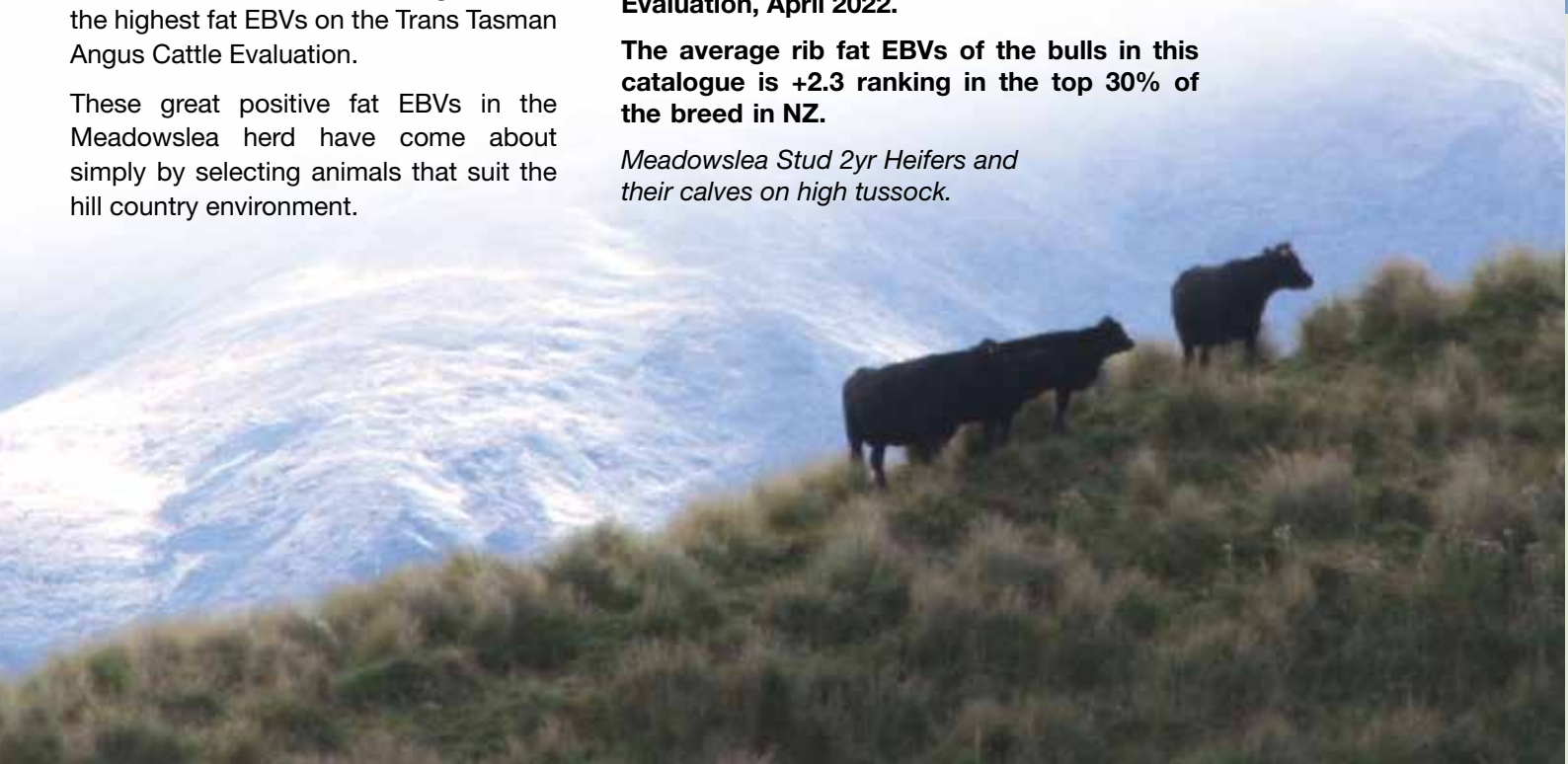

Fertility - The Most Important Economic Trait

David Giddings of Meadowslea Angus in Fairlie says if profit is the goal, then fertility is by far the most important trait cow-calf producers should be selecting for. Studies have shown time and time again that reproductive traits are twice as important as growth traits, which are in turn, twice as important as carcass traits.

Ironically, the majority of the beef industry has been selecting almost exclusively for growth and carcass traits for the last 40-plus years – all at the expense of reproduction.

Because the heritability of growth and carcass traits is very high, it is relatively easy to make changes in those traits. Unfortunately, many breeders in the beef industry mistakenly believe that when it comes to growth and carcass traits, more and bigger are always better. They forget the optimum level for most traits is almost never the same as the maximum level.

IT IS ACTUALLY VERY EASY TO SELECT FOR FERTILITY.

Fertility is more a function of fleshing ability than of anything else – and fleshing ability is more a function of low maintenance requirements than of anything else.

Reproduction cannot take place until maintenance requirements have been met and cows are storing up energy reserves in the form of fat. Since fleshing ability and maintenance requirements are very heritable, fertility is therefore very heritable.

David says bull buyers should look at the key fertility trait EBV's first.

Scrotal Size (SS) – which indicates early onset of puberty on heifer progeny and early rebreeding throughout her lifetime.

Days to Calving (DTC) – this is the measure of the number of days from the day the bull is let in with the mob until the cow calves – the shorter the better over her lifetime production, indicating a higher likelihood of getting in calf in the first cycle.

Rib Fat - positive rib fats are a measure of fleshing and have a major effect on fertility

Body Condition Score (BCS) – this new Breeding Value, introduced by Angus NZ this year, measures the body condition score of the cow at weaning. Established Meadowslea sires are coming out right at the top of the breed on this assessment. Meadowslea F540, Meadowslea Meat Machine and Turihaua Crump all rank in the top 2% in NZ for BCS,

Self-Replacing Index (SRI) – An Angus NZ index generated by compiling data from many of the above traits, particularly fertility but also including moderate cow size and calving ease.

While many in the NZ beef industry has been selecting almost exclusively for growth and carcass traits, Meadowslea Angus have spent the last 40 years selecting for efficient, low-maintenance cattle that can do the most for the least – the kind that can produce and reproduce with minimum inputs in many different environments.

David says “if you think of the feed cost savings from these efficient moderate framed cows, coupled with the extra numbers of calves per herd you are able to sell or fatten, as well as the smaller number of heifers needed for replacements, when you have fewer dry cows – then it’s just a no-brainer decision for your bull selection”

If you don't pamper your cows, then you shouldn't buy bulls from studs that pamper theirs. If you buy bulls from studs that treat their livestock in a way similar to, or tougher than, your management style, there will not be any negative surprises. Bulls can gain weight during breeding, cows can stay in good condition with limited inputs, and as a fortunate side effect you get sappy, easy fleshing calves that prime up early, and easily on grass, and hit their grades quicker.

If fertility is important to you, then you shouldn't purchase bulls that were bred with a focus on growth and carcass traits. Instead, you should purchase bulls that were bred for low-maintenance requirements and fleshing ability.

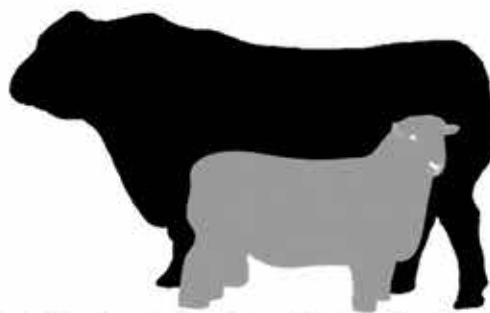

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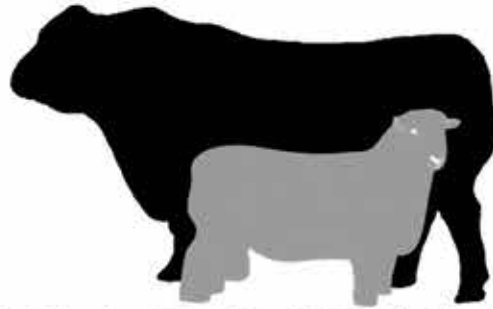
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
